Journey 2007 was a success! Ongoing Project Reports

Each year a team from REAP International here in the U.S. makes the long journey to the country of Vietnam to assess the progress of ongoing projects, to engage in hands-on ministry, to encourage the Vietnam believers who work year-around to accomplish the mission of REAP, and to determine the focus of the upcoming year's ministry. This year we had thirty enthusiastic individuals make the trip to be a part of what God is doing in Vietnam.

Important projects on the June 2007 Journey...

This year, on *Journey 2007*, we were involved in several important projects.

Khe Sanh Orphanage: To begin with, we traveled to REAP's own orphanage in Khe Sanh. This is the orphanage started and funded by REAP International in June 2006. Those who run the orphanage had made great progress in the last year. We found the children to be well cared for and happy in their new home. They had even learned two new hymns to sing for us, in both Vietnamese and in English! They were bright and beautiful and made the long trip worthwhile with each hug and smile. New buildings and facilities had been added with plans for more. Not only are there opportunities to care for more children, but also for whole communities to be won to Christ. *(Pictured are the children from the orphanage)*



Phu Quoc Island Church: The new work on Phu Quoc Island is rapidly expanding as well. We met on the



new property with the pastor and leaders of the church for a tour of the property and to dedicate the property to the Lord. Already the plans for the church are being enlarged to accommodate the people who are being won to Jesus Christ. As you may know, once the new church is built, *it will be the first and only Christian church on the island!*

There is more to come: As we had promised, REAP gave away *fifty new bicycles* to several deserving pastors, Bible school students, and impoverished families. We also saw two homes that had been built for extremely poor families, and a third home was under construction on Phu Quoc Island because of giving Christian people. As always we spent a portion of a day at the orphanage for deaf and mute children. What a joy that was!

We cannot share all that God is doing in Vietnam in this two page newsletter. However, in the coming months, we will be sharing more with you about the various projects and victories won for Christ in Vietnam. But in all our memories of this trip, one thing stands out above all else—one thing is clear—*the harvest is ready to be reaped and many souls are depending on you and me!*
