Phu Quoc Island Project Report—Incredible news!

Thank the Lord for his goodness and to people like you for your generous giving! As you may know, the property on Phu Quoc Island was purchased just a few months ago at a price of \$50,000. Now it belongs to God's people! That's right. The church property has been *paid for completely!* God is so awesome!

But there is no stopping there; the Christian people on Phu Quoc Island are depending on us to fulfill our promise. We are now raising money for the new church building to be built on the property. The estimated cost of the building will be around \$25,000. The church will seat 500 and we believe that God will fill it over and over.

The good news is that we are within \$6,000.00 of having enough to cover the estimated cost of the new church building! Just think about those souls yet to accept Christ that we will see in heaven one day, all because you gave what you could. (In the photo to the right, worshippers already overflow a small home.)



Perhaps as you are reading this newsletter, the REAP International team will be on the ground in Vietnam doing what they can to encourage and expedite the fulfillment of this and many more dreams—and don't ever doubt it, with God, dreams come true!

Other projects on the June 2007 Journey...

Each year REAP International takes a group of people on the trip we call "The Journey." The Journey is the exciting culmination of the previous year's labor of love for the various projects in Vietnam. It is a time to help out on the mission field, to celebrate victories with the Christian people of Vietnam, to visit orphanages and give scholarships and gifts to the beautiful children, to wield a paint brush or a shovel, to witness first hand what is actually taking place, and to never let the government of Vietnam forget that we support those we help to win to Christ.

This year, on *Journey 2007*, we will be covering several important projects. To begin with, we will be visiting and participating in the new work on Phu Quoc Island, which you read about above. Already the crowds for church services exceed the space available. Once the new church is built, *it will be the first and only Christian church on the island!*

REAP will be giving away *fifty new bicycles* to several deserving pastors, bible school students, and impoverished families. We also plan to *construct two or three Agape Houses* near the church for poor families on Phu Quoc Island. It will be a great testimony of the love of Jesus Christ to an island dominated by the Buddhist religion. Finally, we will be spending a day at the orphanage for deaf and mute children. That is always a special joy. Space does not allow for an explanation of all the projects planned, but one thing is clear—*the harvest is ready to be reaped!*

As REAP’s Director, Dr. Wayne Wright, has said before, “We have been presented the opportunity of a lifetime – but *we must seize this opportunity* of a lifetime.
