Building Churches – New opportunity and a new priority

The church pictured to the right is the result of a house church began by one of the church members who had been deserted by her husband several years ago. For 20 years she has been praying for the church to have its own building, so recently she donated a small piece of land next to her house for a church. Presently, 70-80 people meet on Sunday for worship and those local members were able to raise \$8,000 for a new building, but they donated that money to another church that needed money to finish their new building.

Last year they raised \$5,000 and started construction, but then ran out of money. Through Mission Vietnam, private donations, and with the help of church friends, family, and others, the remaining money was raised and now Hiep Binh Phuoc has a nice, new building in which to worship God.

Never stop praying and never stop giving. More churches are ready to be built right now and we are depending on your help!
